1. Pursuant to the provisions of reference (a), Petitioner, a former enlisted member of the United States Marine Corps Reserve filed enclosure (1) with this Board requesting that his naval record be corrected to show that he transferred to the Retired Reserve vice being discharged on 7 June 1982.

2. The Board, consisting of Mr. Morgan, Mr. Pfeiffer and Mr. Ivins, reviewed Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice on 2 June 1999 and, pursuant to its regulations, determined that the corrective action indicated below should be taken on the available evidence of record. Documentary material considered by the Board consisted of the enclosures, naval records, and applicable statutes, regulations and policies.

3. The Board, having reviewed all the facts of record pertaining to Petitioner's allegations of error and injustice, finds as follows:

a. Before applying to this Board, Petitioner exhausted all administrative remedies available under existing law and regulations within the Department of the Navy.

b. Although it appears that enclosure (1) was not filed in a timely manner, it is in the interest of justice to waive the statute of limitations and review the application on its merits.

c. Petitioner reenlisted in the Marine Corps Reserve on 8 March 1980 in the grade of SGT (E-5) and subsequently extended that enlistment for three months. The record shows that he transferred to the Individual Ready Reserve (IRR) on 14 May 1982. Shortly thereafter he was issued a Notification of Eligibility for Retired Pay at Age 60. He was honorably discharged on 7 June 1982 at the expiration of his enlistment as extended. The record shows that Petitioner has been approved for retired pay as a former member, to start on 19 August 1999, his 60th birthday.

d. The Board did not request an advisory opinion in this

case. However, the Board is aware that Headquarters Marine Corps has routinely recommended corrective action if an individual was in good standing in the Marine Corps Reserve and there is no explanation in the record why they were discharged and not retired.

e. The Board is aware that the Uniform Retirement Date Act, 5 U.S.C. 8301 requires that the effective date of any retirement be the first day of the month.

CONCLUSION:

Upon review and consideration of all the evidence of record the Board concludes that Petitioner's request warrants favorable action. The Board notes that Petitioner was in good standing in the Marine Corps Reserve at the time of his discharge and would have been retired if he had requested it. Given the circumstances, the Board concludes that the record should be corrected to show that he transferred to the Retired Reserve in the grade of SGT, vice being discharged on 7 June 1982. In view of the requirements of the Uniform Retirement Date Act, the Board further concludes that the transfer to the Retired Reserve should be effective on 1 June 1982.

The Board further concludes that this Report of Proceedings should be filed in Petitioner's naval record so that all future reviewers will understand his correct status in the Retired Reserve.

RECOMMENDATION:

a. That Petitioner's naval record be corrected to show that he transferred to the Retired Reserve in the grade of SGT on 1 June 1982 vice being discharged on 7 June 1982.

b. That this Report of Proceedings be filed in Petitioner's naval record.

4. It is certified that a quorum was present at the Board's review and deliberations, and that the foregoing is a true and complete record of the Board's proceedings in the above entitled matter.


