1. The requested correction cannot be accomplished, administratively at this headquarters.
2. The applicant is requesting 1 point be added to make Retirement Year Ending (RYE) 6 June 1993 a year of satisfactory Federal service.
3. The following is an analysis of the circumstances surrounding the case:
 - a. The applicant performed travel during two-week annual tour.
 - b. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] was informed that [REDACTED] would be awarded 1 point for [REDACTED] travel time, however at a later date [REDACTED] was informed that [REDACTED] would not be awarded this 1 point.
4. We recommend this application be approved based on the fact the member was informed initially that [REDACTED] would be awarded this 1 additional point and then at a later date was informed [REDACTED] would not. Applicant was performing in good faith.
5. If this application is approved, 1 non-paid Inactive Duty Training (IDT) point would need to be awarded for RYE 6 June 1993. The applicant's record would then show 12 Active Duty points, 23 IDT points, 0 Extension Course Institute points and 15 membership points resulting in 50 total and retirement points and a year of satisfactory Federal service for RYE 6 June 1993.
