

Under the authority of Section 1552, Title 10, United States Code and Air Force Instruction 36-2603, and having assured compliance with the provisions of the above regulation, the decision of the Air Force Board for Correction of Military Records is announced, and it is directed that:

The pertinent military records of the Department of the Air Force relating to [REDACTED], 124-60-3546, be corrected to show that he was discharged on 17 February 1998 with a separation code of JBK, rather than-MBK, and that, at the time of his discharge, competent authority determined that he was entitled to one-half separation pay.

The applicant, while serving in the grade of staff sergeant, was discharged from the Air Force on 17 Feb 98 under the provisions of AFI 36-3208 (Completion of Required Active Service). He served 10 years, 03 months and 14 days active service.

Requested Action. The applicant is requesting his separation code (SPD) be corrected to indicated that he was involuntarily discharged.

Facts. Applicant was advised on 31 Oct 97 that he was ineligible for reenlistment due to medical disqualification/pending medical evaluation board evaluation (RE Code 4K). The separation code (SPD) "KBK" was incorrectly assigned as indicated on his DD Form 214.

Conclusion and Recommendation. Recommend approval. Applicant should have been assigned SPD Code "JBK" which would have been the correct separation code for a member who had been denied reenlistment for medical disqualification (RE Code 4K). Recommend AFBCMR direct applicant's record be corrected to indicated he was assigned SPD Code "JBK" and was entitled to one-half separation pay at the time of his discharge on 17 Feb 98. He has filed a timely request.
