Applicant requests his undesirable discharge be change to honorable. Applicant's submission is at Exhibit A.

Applicant's military personnel records are not available. Therefore, the facts surrounding his separation from the Air Force cannot be verified.

After careful consideration of applicant's request, we note that there are no records available for review and applicant has not provided documentation revealing the circumstances of his discharge. Therefore, we have no records upon which to determine whether or not applicant's separation was appropriate. However, based on the presumption of regularity in the conduct of governmental affairs and without evidence to the contrary, we must assume that the applicant's discharge was proper and in compliance with appropriate directives. Therefore, we find no basis upon which to favorably consider this application.

The Board staff is directed to inform applicant of this decision. Applicant should also be informed that this decision is final and will only be reconsidered upon the presentation of new relevant evidence which was not reasonably available at the time the application was filed.
